Poppy Bike Two is to be built from the proceeds generated by Bike One and it has been decided to build a trike. This will lend itself to easy conversion if required, should the winner be disabled, enabling the rider to enjoy the mobility offered by three wheeled transport. Strong links with the National Association for Bikers with a Disability (NABD) will help us to achieve this.

Although still in the design stages, it is intended to use a 6 cylinder 1300cc engine, kindly donated by Dave 'Basher' Prout, to power the trike chassis which has already been sourced by the build team.

The bike is being built to raise money which will be given to the Royal British Legion in celebration of its 90th year since foundation and will be themed appropriately for this commemorative occasion.

Once the design is finalised, the team will be looking once again for help, donations and fund raising ideas to complete this exciting project.
